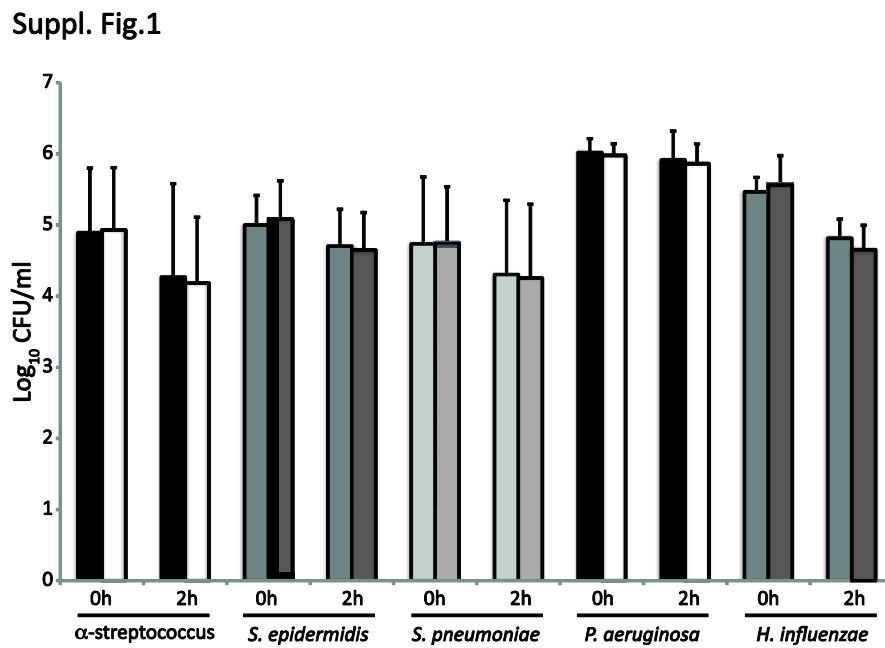

**Suppl. Figure 1: Anti-microbial effect of thrombin-activated plasma.** Different bacterial species ( $5 \times 10^5$  CFU/ml in 12,9 mM sodium citrate) were incubated with citrated plasma diluted 1:100 in sodium citrate in the absence (filled bars) or presence (striped bars) of thrombin. At 0 and 2 h, bacterial numbers were determined by plating serial dilutions of the sample on agar plates. The figure shows means +/- SD of at least three independent experiments.
